

PAST SIMPLE **TO BE** (ESSERE)

Forma affermativa

I	Was
You	Were
He/she/it	Was
We	were
You	Were
they	were

Yesterday, I was at home!

Ieri ero a casa

Two months ago we were at school!

Due mesi fa eravamo a scuola

Forma negativa

I	Was not / wasn't
You	Were not / weren't
He/she/it	Was not / wasn't
We	Were not / weren't
You	Were not / weren't
they	Were not / weren't

We were not (weren't) at school yesterday

Non eravamo a scuola ieri

She wasn't outside two days ago

Non era fuori due giorni fa

Forma interrogativa

Was	I?
Were	You?
Was	He/she/it?
Were	We?
Were	You?
were	They?

Were you at school yesterday?

Eri a scuola ieri?

Where were they last month?

Dove erano (essi) lo scorso mese?

Was she at home two days ago?

Era (lei) a casa due giorni fa?

Usi del Past Simple

- Fatti iniziati e **conclusi** in un tempo passato
- Si accompagna **sempre** ad avverbi di tempo finito e passato:
 - **Yesterday** (ieri)
 - **Last** (la scorsa) week (settimana), month (mese), year (anno), century (secolo), days of the week (Monday, Tuesday ecc)
 - **Ago** (fa) two minutes ago (due minuti fa), 3 days ago (3 giorni fa)
